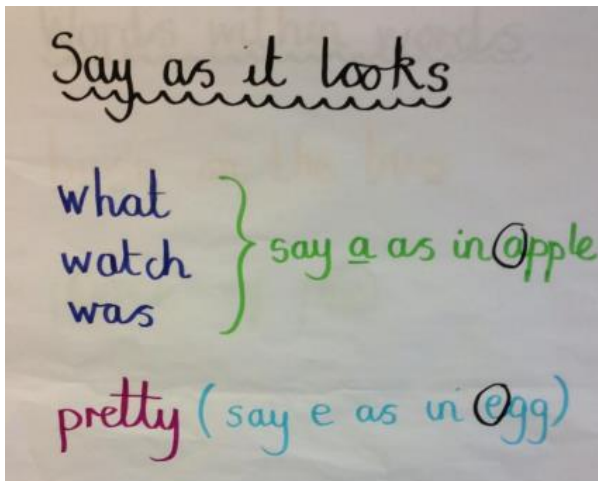


Top tips for helping your children with **RED** words

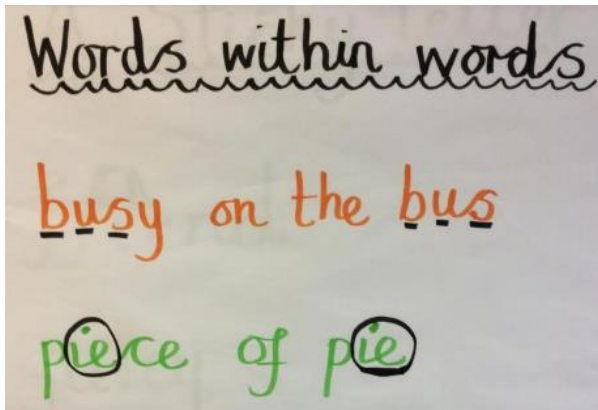
These are words that you can't sound out. The children can't use their "Fred talk"

"You can't Fred a red."

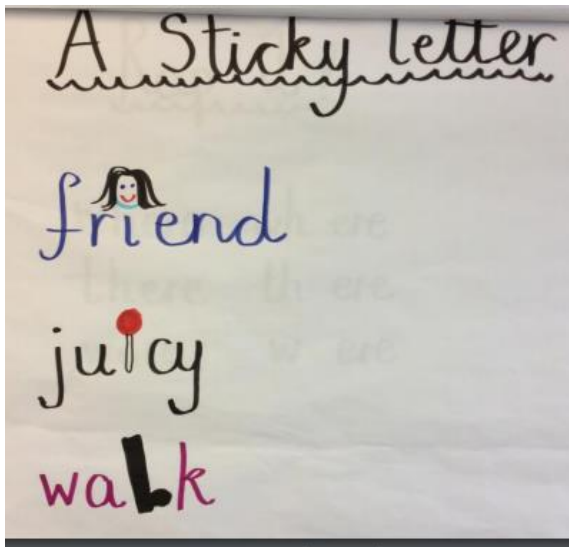
Say it as it looks: pe/o/ple k/night



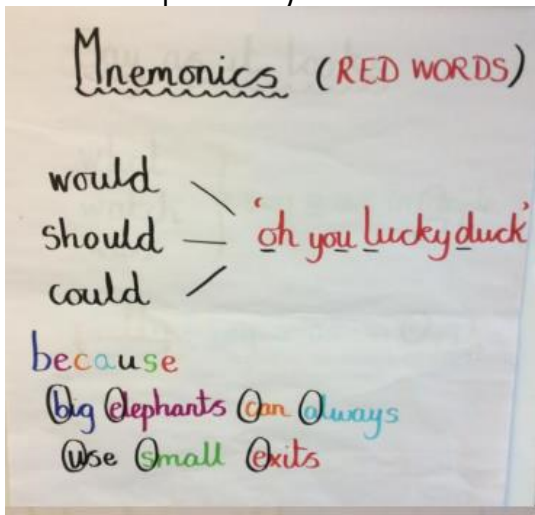
Word in a word: what what hat? busy busy on the bus
