At Reigate Parish we are proud of the opportunities that every child has to engage with music throughout the school. From weekly singing assemblies led by our music coordinator to performances and external events, our children have a variety of opportunities throughout the school year.

Collective Worship

Collective worship is an integral part of the school day where the children meet together, learn about the Christian faith through songs in an engaging way and practise for end of term services. The songs are chosen appropriately according to their age group and are learnt in a weekly singing assembly.

Performances

We believe that opportunities for children to perform is important for building their confidence and celebrating their successes. In year 2 and year 4, a choir takes part in the Redhill & Reigate Music Festival, performing alongside children from other local schools.

In Key Stage 1, the children work towards a Nativity, learning songs and rehearsing lines for the production. In years 3 and 4, the children work towards a carol concert showcasing their learning and the choir and ukulele club. It is always a privilege to share these occasions with the whole school and with families.

The Junior Summer Concert is a special time to celebrate the closing year in a display of individual and collaborative achievements.
