

Parents are thinking and choosing the school for their child to be in for Key Stage 2. Three reasons to pick Reigate Parish:

1. We are a **high-attaining school** with our data consistently placing us above national and Surrey averages in reading, writing and maths at the end of Key Stage 1 and above national and Surrey averages for the assessment at the end of Reception. Our children across the school attain well and make good progress. We have seen good attainment and progress for our Year 3 children last year. This high challenge and high academic achievement is something that will remain a key feature of the school and will be throughout Key Stage 2 (KS2). Parents know about the extra support and interventions we give to children who have additional educational needs, and that remains a key feature of Reigate Parish but we are a high-attaining school offering stretch and challenge to all our children.
2. We employ an excellent **specialist PE teacher** who leads and organises the external PE competitions, events and tournaments for KS2. Sport is prioritised at Reigate Parish. In Year 3 we achieved impressive results which puts us in a strong position to be a real contender to win many of the Year 5 and 6 tournaments and competitions. Last academic year our PE teacher organised a series of friendly football matches for Year 3 boys and girls and these were so well-received that they are now a fixture on this year's sports calendar. Being a smaller school means many more children have the opportunity to represent their school.

3. We have on offer a **wide range of clubs, residentials and extra-curricular activities**. We introduce each year more clubs (this year we have teacher-led clubs and more peripatetic teaching – piano lessons, Rockacademy). We have a residential for every year group which is entwined with the topic and they are already planned for Year 5 and 6. Different KS2 year groups will lead on different special events – Harvest service, carol concert, summer music concert, enterprise projects and the Year 6 Summer Production. All year groups will use the local environment – Year 3 have partnership days with a local school on Redhill Common, year groups use Reigate Priory Park for different lessons, Year 4 is singing at Reigate School, KS2 sports afternoon in using Reigate St Mary's field. We will build upon this exciting provision as we grow.
