

Swimming for Year 3 Children and Catch-up for Year 4 Children

In Year 3 during the summer term children have weekly swimming lessons at Reigate Grammar School with two swimming instructors, employed by the school. Children are taught in ability groupings so they make the best progress week on week. The last swimming lesson is a "Gala" lesson for parents to watch their child swimming and to see the progress they have made. For those children who do not reach the 25m national curriculum by the end of year 3 then there will be catch up lessons timetabled.
