Pavement Works Outside School

We have now been informed that the pavement works outside Reigate Parish Church Primary School will begin on Monday 30th October. This is the first day back after half term so please allow extra time for your journey from that day onwards.

Work being done on the pavement along Blackborough Road

Mrs Davis, following on from the questions raised at the Parents' Forum this week, wrote to the Works Communication Team in the Local Highway Services. The queries were forwarded to the contractor who answered them:

- 1) Could the work be done in small sections, thereby allowing traffic and parking to flow?

Each section will be determined by the length of the temporary traffic lights and all works on one side will be totally completed in each section.

- 2) Is it the case that the whole pavement along one side is dug up?
Existing parking will be allowed so long as it does not cause any hold ups with the controlled traffic lights areas.

- 3) Is it true there are going to be three sets of traffic lights needed to control traffic?

Three different temporary traffic signals will be required to control vehicles through the working areas but they will only be working individually i.e. 4-way lights at the cross road at the junction with Ringley Park Avenue, then 2-way lights single flow in the middle section. Then 3-way lights at the junction with Crakell Road. The works will be carried out in small, rolling sections and the team on site are very good at keeping the surrounding residents and businesses informed. The works rarely have any impact on passing traffic (apart from the lights) and we often carry them out outside schools as these are priority areas to keep maintained. Due to this our teams on site are very experienced in providing the access requirements a school and its many visitors need. From what I can gather, only sections of the pavement will be dug up at once to minimise impact.

The Governing Body of Reigate Parish Church Primary School will be starting the process of appointing a new Parent Governor after the October half term. Is this something you might be interested in? The key roles of any Governing Body as laid out by the Government is set out in *The 1998 School Standards & Framework Act* and is defined as:

It is school improvement (raising standards) that is the heart and the purpose of school governance. Governing Bodies have a strong focus on three core strategic functions:

1. Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction
2. Holding the Headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils
3. Overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is spent well.
