# **Parents' Evenings**

Parents' evenings this term are on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> October and the sign-up sheets are now available in the school office for parents to sign up for a slot to see their child's teacher. Please make sure that you do sign up. We are looking into an online programme where parents can sign up to an appointment with their teacher and aim to have it in place for the March parent/teacher interview meetings.

#### **Dodgeball Tournament**

Only two weeks left before our Ultimate Dodgeball tournament kicks off. In PE, classes have been learning the game of dodgeball and are gearing up for the upcoming house competition. In class teachers have been discussing who the British Heart Foundation are, what they do and why we want to support them. In 2015 we managed to raise an impressive £3,072,76, a target I would love us to beat this year. If an individual pupil manages to raise £50 or more they will receive their very own dodgeball. 36 of our pupils were successful in doing so last time. Thank you in advance for supporting our school, and pupils in raising money for the British Heart Foundation.

#### Clubs

All clubs that are run by outside providers give us a register of the children who have paid to attend. Once we have all the registers the teachers are able to know the children who will be attending the clubs and can ensure that they are passed over to the people running the club. Children who have their club in the new junior building are escorted across the playground to get changed in that building. The children will then be walked back to the main school entrance to be collected at the end of the club.

If your child starts a club after the official start date for clubs then you will need to let the class teacher know to add their name to our list. We do ask the club providers to update their lists but that information may not come from them immediately.

The Children's, Standards and Learning Committee met on Tuesday evening. Governors spent much of the meeting discussing the breadth of children's learning and how Reigate Parish can ensure the most creative curriculum is taught. Governors have asked for a report on this in the next meeting. Governors also looked closely at attendance data and noticed that the number of unauthorised absences and lateness of pupils have increased over the last two years, they were concerned about the impact this might have on the pupils' learning as well as the disruption caused to the class on the lateness of pupils. Governors are particularly looking forward to their Governor Monitoring walks this year and seeing for themselves the creativity shown in teaching the pupils over the school.
