

PTA Community Partnership Guidelines

Background

Reigate Parish Church Primary School is currently expanding to be a 420-place school for children aged from 4 to 11 years. This expansion to a full primary School, which began in September 2016, will be complete with the September 2019 intake. The school currently has ten classes organised as mixed ability, parallel classes across the five year groups. The school has a distinctive Christian ethos which is at the heart of the school and provides an inclusive, caring and supportive environment where children, of any faith or no faith, learn to flourish in a setting shaped by Christian values. We welcome applications from all members of the community and expect all parents to respect the Christian ethos of the school and its importance to our community.

These guidelines set out the principles by which the Parent Teacher Association of the School can work with commercial partners to generate additional funding. The use of funds generated by commercial partnerships will be decided by the Headteacher.

Community Partnership Guidelines

- Any organisation wishing to partner with the School cannot be involved in a sector of the economy clearly in breach of the School's Christian ethos.
- Specific sectors of the economy impacted include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - Adult entertainment
 - Gambling
 - Pubs and bars
- Commercial arrangements with partners are the responsibility of the PTA Chairperson at the School.
- Commercial partnerships will be considered valid for the duration of the academic year in which they are concluded. Both parties have the option to extend the partnership in the event of mutual agreement.
- The School Governors or Headteacher reserve the right to render invalid any commercial partnerships in the event of due cause. Depending upon the nature of the commercial arrangement, any dispute on the balance of value outstanding shall be settled by the School Governors.
