

## **Chair Report – Review of Spring/Summer Term**

### **Cake Sales & Film Night:**

- The cake sales have been really well supported and have raised over £830 in this academic year. The Summer Term sees the return of Ice Cream Fridays which the children all seem to enjoy.
- We haven't had a Summer Term Move Night as a new team need to be found to run it. Assuming we can get a team together for next year, we will run x3 Movie Nights throughout the academic year, ideally in Autumn Term 1, Spring Term 2 and Summer Term 1.

### **Quiz Night:**

- The Quiz Night was a fun evening and seemed to be enjoyed by everyone that attended.
- The event raised over £1,000.

### **Valentine's Disco:**

- Chrissie Purdy did a great job at organising the Valentine's Disco. The children enjoyed it and the event raised around £600. Next year we will reduce the snack to one item, i.e. a chocolate bar and drink to allow more time for the children to enjoy the disco.
- We desperately need a replacement organiser for next year's disco and ideally, it would be great if someone could come on board now (perhaps the team may want to be involved in organising the Summer Disco with the Library Fund team).
- Ideally, the "Disco" team would organise a Valentine's and Summer disco.

### **Mother's Day:**

- Was a great success, raising over £275.00 - well done Caroline and Ellen!!
- Ellen White and Rebecca Findlay will be thinking of a similar idea that can be rolled out for Father's Day.

### **Fundraising Fortnight:**

- It raised a fantastic £1,280.50, this was slightly lower than year but this was most likely due to the Library Fund launch.
- We think it would be beneficial to create more hype around it so that everyone is engaged with it.

### **The Giving Machine:**

We now have 84 givers and have generated 1,169 donations which equates to £649.74. Parents need reminding of this, both to sign-up up if not already done so and to continue using if they have.

### **Summary:**

Last term saw the PTA raise nearly £4,000, all of which goes into resources for the school and the education of our children. This period typically raises the smallest amount over the course of the academic year as there are no big events e.g. fairs and fireworks. From a fundraising perspective, this highlights why these events are so important and why support and involvement from the whole of the school community is vital.
