## Operation Christmas Child

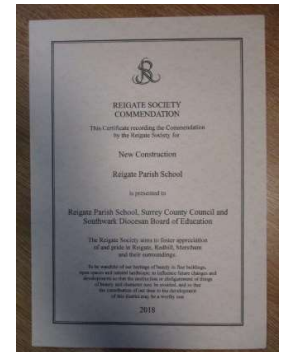
